- ▶ Nutrient Management

Suggested areas of interest are NOT a prerequisite for funding, but requestors should make a strong case as to the importance of their topic for the current year and why the workshop should be viewed as a priority for STAC, and appropriate for STAC support.

- ▶ Suggested that themes should specifically tie into Chesapeake Bay Agreement, two year-workplans, or Management Board priorities
