The Facility



Currently permitted to produce 80,000 tons of finished product each year.

- **Began operation in July 2001**
- **Perdue AgriRecycle has handled 694,042 total tons of raw litter.**
- **325,506 tons of finished product has been marketed and shipped out of our plant. A minimum of 50% was shipped outside of the Chesapeake Bay Watershed**

Equivalent Nutrient Removal

- ✓ **54.6 million pounds nitrogen**
- ✓ **27.7 million pounds phosphorus**
- ✓ **41.6 million pounds of potassium**

- **MicroSTART60 had an initial NPK of 4-3-3 in 2001**
- **MicroSTART60 currently an NPK of 3-2-3 due to the changes in the diet program of the poultry industry**
