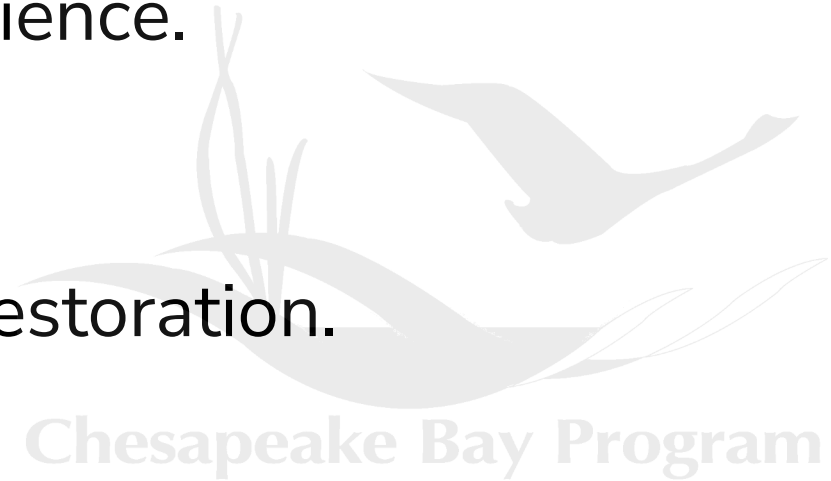

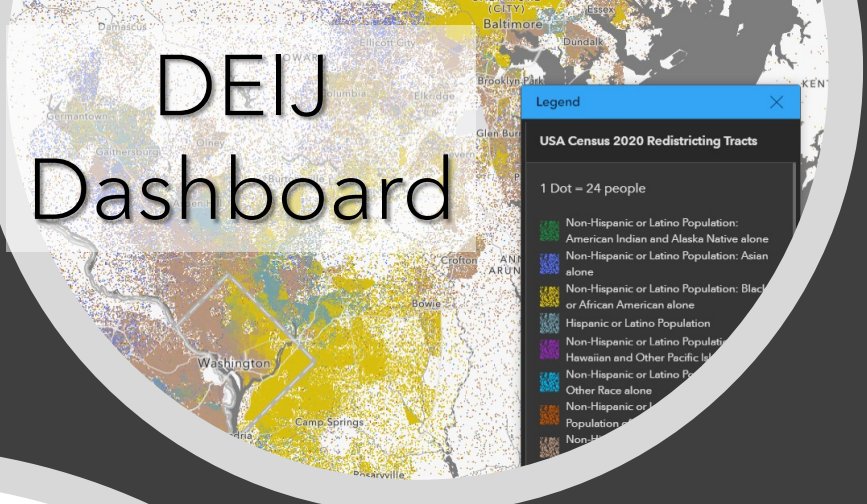

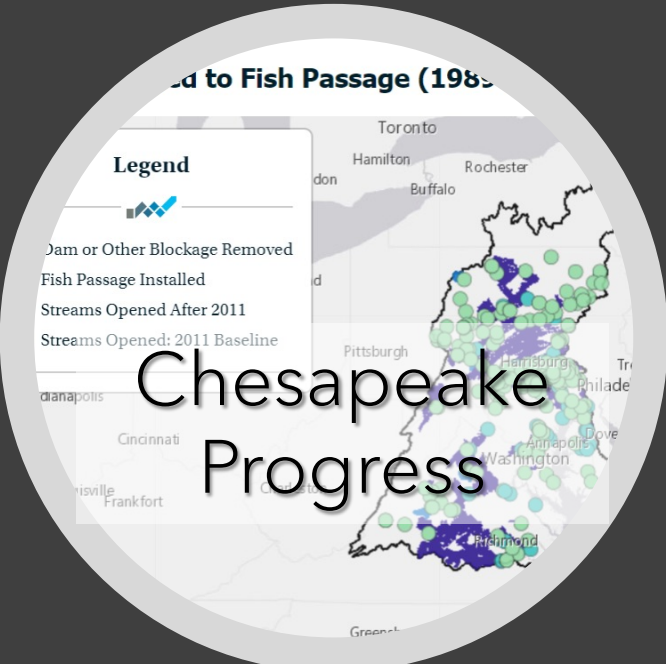

DEIJ Dashboard

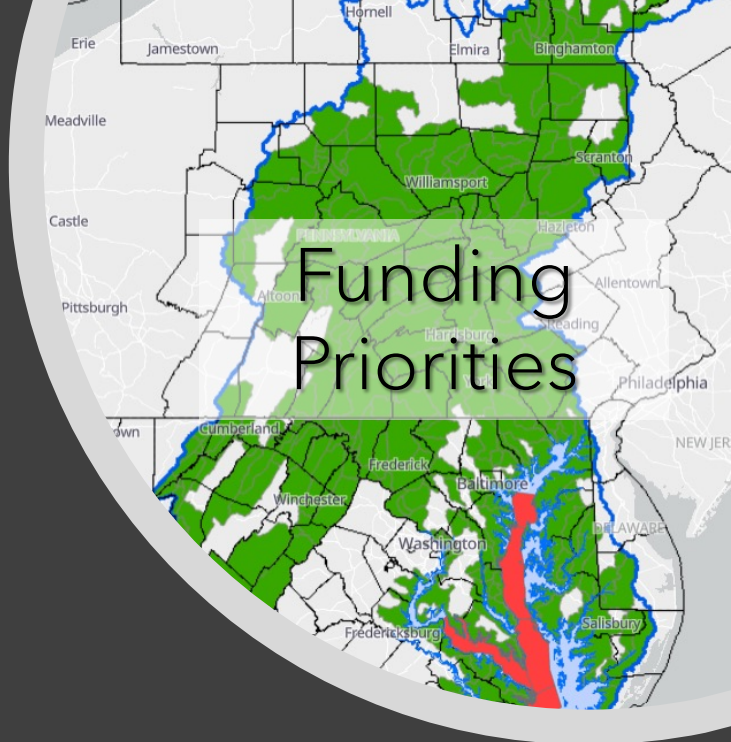


Progress to Fish Passage (1980s)

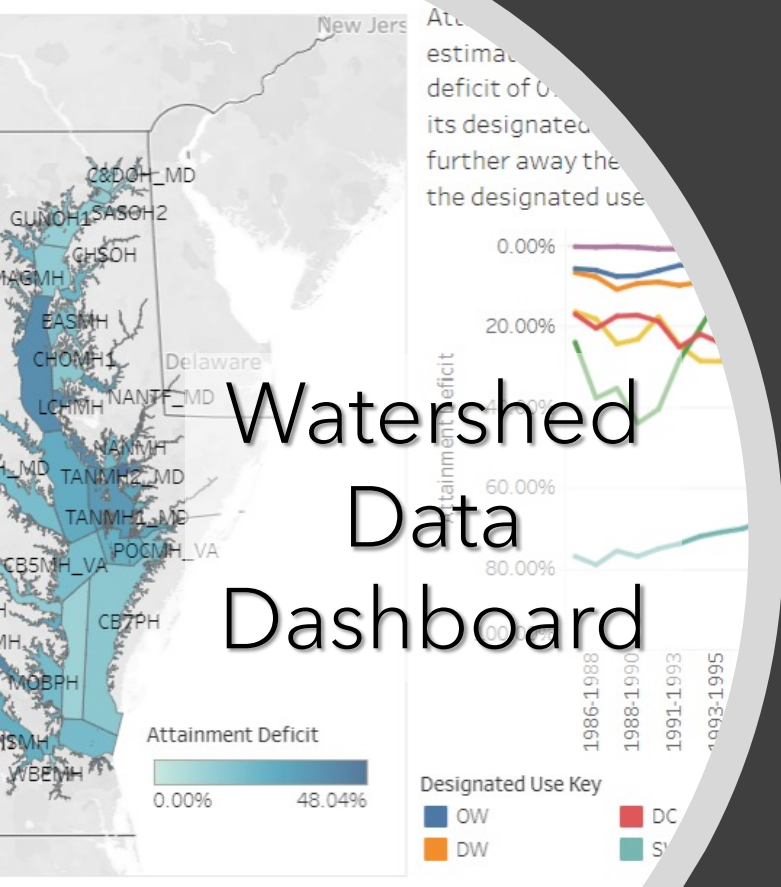

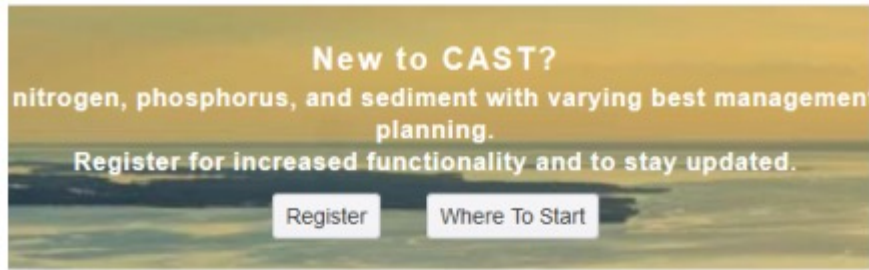
