Clean streams and rivers flowing through resilient landscapes, cared for by the people who live, work, and play in the Chesapeake Bay watershed.
















Leveraging existing programs

Forest Buffer Incentive Program

- \$4,000 Conservation Voucher per acre of riparian forest buffer
- leverage USDA or other riparian forest buffer programs
- Vouchers can be used for any conservation purpose including public funding gaps
- All streams to need to be buffered
- Maintenance pool
